On October 10th, the Complex held a *Faith in Blue Event* which is an initiative to reinforce the connections between law enforcement professionals and the communities they serve.



The Complex also hosted the JX2 “Truck Roping.” This was a record-setting event for the facility and competitive team roping. The facility sold out of stalls and R/V hookups and stored 134 horses in “temporary stalls.” There were an estimated 1,200 people at the facility with approximately 1,000 of those being out of county. The event generated \$20,536 in facility revenue and \$6,518 in concessions revenue for a total of \$27,054 in gross revenue (the largest to date for both). *The event was the largest recorded team roping in history ever held east of the Mississippi with 3574 teams/entries.*

For the second year, we also hosted the “Bullys In the Boro” a dog show exclusively for bulldog breeds. The event generated \$1,643 in gross revenue with \$773 of the total from concessions. The facility was also utilized by the Statesboro Chamber of Commerce’s Ag Committee to host their monthly meeting. In October, the Public Riding Program had a total of 72 participants and generated \$465 in revenue (sold 3 annual passes in October). Increased participation in the Public Riding Program is directly related to roping practice. The formation of a local Roping & Rodeo Club based out of the facility will hopefully start in January 2021.
